Want to learn Photoshop but intimidated by the training courses offered to professionals? ***This workshop will teach you the basic skills you need to photograph and correct your artwork for submission to competitions, etc.*** You will also learn how to use Photoshop as a "sketching" tool to help you work from photographs. **The workshop is for those who have Photoshop or Adobe Elements on their home computers.** Ray will teach both programs. Each participant will have a computer to work on and will have ample time to learn and practice tasks. Experimenting at home between classes is highly encouraged.

Day 1: We will go over the menus in both Photoshop and Elements so you will become familiar with what they offer and where to find things. Pixels, resolution, dpi vs ppi, and all that confusing stuff will be explained. We will discuss different file formats and how to save your images in them. Cropping and sizing images, adjusting colors, values, focus, and tips on getting your best pictures will be covered.

Day 2: Learning to work with layers, an important and powerful (and easy to understand) tool in Photoshop. We will spend time: Joining two pictures to make a "panorama", adjusting the lights and darks and saving separate versions for reference. Cutting objects from one photo and putting them into a second one. Erasing unwanted objects from photos. Making black and white versions, making 3 or 4 value and/or color versions of photos. Setting up a grid for transfer to canvas and turning it on and off.

Ray has been working professionally with Photoshop for over 20 years and will have you up to speed quickly. Ample handouts and notes will be supplied for post-class reference.
