Learn to how to paint from your own photographs as if you were really on location!

Most artists paint exactly what they see instead of pushing the envelope and creating works of art. One of the great tools for the modern painter is the camera. With digital images and today's technological advances the creative process has many tools in which an artist can use. Even then the camera lies to the viewer. Photographs tend to have limited values, color range and usually need adjusted to create correct values, shapes and mood desired. Learn how and when to make adjustments and a statement.

Students must supply their own photographs, equipment, and art supplies. A supply list will be provided upon registration.

Chuck Marshall attended one year at the Cincinnati Art Academy before moving to southern California, where he studied at the California Art Institute. While out west he studied with various artists that worked in the Southwest and California Plein Air styles. (Plein Air is a French term meaning to paint from life, or on location.)

Throughout his career, Chuck has also worked as an illustrator and graphic designer. His illustrations have been featured in magazines, books, popcorn tins, as well as prints and greeting cards. His fine art has been published in International Artist and American Artist Magazine. Chuck has won numerous awards and has also performed as a judge in juried art competitions. His work hangs in many private and corporate collections, and he has been asked to demonstrate his craft for art groups, teaching both illustration and fine art classes. He is a member of many art groups local and national.
